

'Generosity" It's a concept that we don't focus on much in our society. In fact, it seems that in our society, generosity is on the decline. Currently, fewer than half of U.S. households now donate to charitable causes, a sharp decline from 65% in 2008. The rate of volunteerism has also declined significantly over the last decade.

Now there are many reasons for these declines. But even non-religious researchers attribute this to the fact that religious affiliation has declined and in turn so has generosity.

That is one of the many reasons I am grateful for Good Samaritan. Because of your faithfulness and generosity, lives continue to be transformed through you. Galatians 5:22-23 tells us "But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control." Generosity is a natural outpouring of God's Spirit at work in us.

Our Stewardship Theme this year is Transforming Generosity. Because generosity also has the power to reshape us, like soft clay in a potter's hands. When we see giving as an investment in God's kingdom rather than merely meeting budgets, we become vessels shaped by divine love. Too often, we settle for surviving and let our hearts harden like clay left out in the sun. Yet, Jesus invites us to thrive by placing ourselves in God's hands to be fashioned for a holy purpose.

# A PRAYER OF THANKSGIVING


Lord God, on this day of Thanksgiving, we ask your blessings on our family, our friends, our home, our health—and on the food we are about to eat.

Good Sam will be getting 50 Angel Tags this year for the students in Addison. You have the chance to make a child's Christmas better.




